Below you will find a list of basic supplies to help get you started with wonderful alcohol inks!

There are many brands of inks, papers, and tools, but I am sharing with you the ones that I really **enjoy**, and that I am using in my video series!

Basic Supplies:

- Alcohol Ink (I like Ranger Inks) <u>Joggles</u> or <u>Amazon</u>
- Alcohol Ink Mixative (Ranger Inks) <u>Joggles</u> or <u>Amazon</u>
- Blending Solution (Ranger Inks) <u>Joggles</u> or <u>Amazon</u>
- 90% Isopropyl Alcohol <u>Amazon</u>
- Dropper Bottle at local craft store, or pipette at Amazon
- Applicator Tool (Ranger Inks) <u>Joggles</u> or <u>Amazon</u>

or Mini Blending Tool (Ranger Inks) - Joggles or Amazon

- Yupo Paper Joggles or Amazon
- Glossy Cardstock (Ranger or Mohawk) -<u>Joggles</u> or <u>Mohawk on Amazon</u> this is for 250 sheets (apx \$33), but worth it if you decide you love these inks!
- Felt (Ranger) <u>Joggles</u> or, cut up a piece of craft felt!
- Straws/Stirrers
- Q-tips

If you have never used alcohol inks before, I suggest you start with a minimum of:

- 2-3 colors of ink,
- 1 mixative (metallic)
- Felt
- glossy cardstock.

This will allow you to experiment without spending too much money on supplies you aren't sure about.

<u>Joggles.com</u> seems to have the best prices on individual bottles of ink (09/02/2016). As I said in the video, I am not affiliated with Joggles, I just love them! I love their product demo videos, and they have excellent customer service, etc. But, please, shop around!

Another alternative is to go to your local craft store and use your 40-50% Off coupon.
